RE: COLORADO REPUBLICAN PRIMARY SURVEY TOPLINE RESULTS

Magellan Data and Mapping Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of a 937N survey of likely Republican primary voters in Colorado. The interviews were conducted April 19th, 2010. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 3.17% at the 95 percent confidence interval. A more detailed presentation will follow.

T1. Are you registered to vote as a Republican, a Democrat or an unaffiliated voter?

Republican.....100%

T2. How likely are you to vote in the Republican primary election this August?

Extremely Likely..... 83%
Very Likely 10%
Somewhat Likely 7%

T3. If the primary election to choose a Republican nominee for US Senate was being held today, for whom would you vote if the candidates were Jane Norton, Tom Wiens, Ken Buck, Cleve Tidwell or someone else?

Ken Buck 32%

Cleve Tidwell..... 1%
