RE: COLORADO REPUBLICAN PRIMARY SURVEY TOPLINE RESULTS

Magellan Data and Mapping Strategies are pleased to present the topline results of a 575N survey of likely 2010 Republican primary voters in Colorado. The interviews were conducted March 14th, 2010. This survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.1% at the 95 percent confidence interval. A more detailed presentation will follow.

T1. Are you registered to vote as a Republican, a Democrat or an unaffiliated voter?

Republican.....100%

T2. How likely are you to vote in the August Republican Primary election to choose a candidate for Governor, and US Senate?

Extremely Likely..... 89%
Very Likely 7%
Somewhat Likely 4%

Thinking now about the Republican primary elections -

T3. If the Republican primary election to choose a candidate for US Senate was being held today, for whom would you vote if the candidates were Jane Norton, Tom Wiens, Ken Buck, Cleve Tidwell or someone else?

Jane Norton..... 41%
Ken Buck 15%
Tom Wiens 13%
Another Candidate..... 5%
Cleve Tidwell..... 1%
Undecided..... 25%

T15. Now for statistical purposes, are you a man or a woman?

Female..... 51%
Male..... 49%

T16. Which of the following age groups applies to you?

18-34..... 6%
35-44..... 10%
45-54..... 21%
55-64..... 24%
65 Plus..... 39%
