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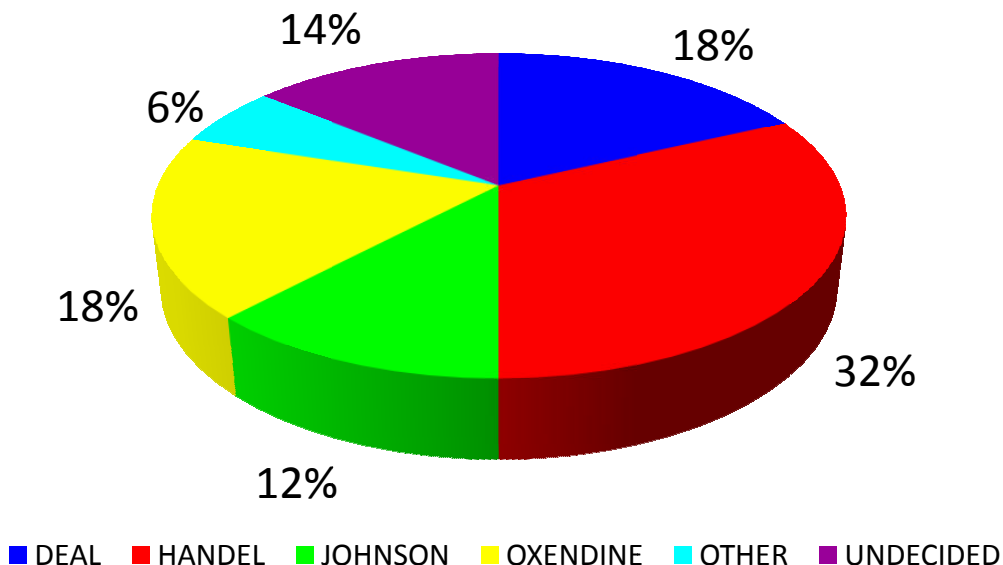

Ballot Test

- **Karen Handel has a 14 point lead over her closest opponent: Handel 32%/Deal 18%/Oxendine 18%/Johnson 12%/6% other/14% undecided.**
- **Gingrich is leading Huckabee by 5 points in a hypothetical 2012 GOP Presidential Primary: (Gingrich 30%/Huckabee 25%/Romney 14% /Palin 12% /Barbour 5%/12% undecided.**

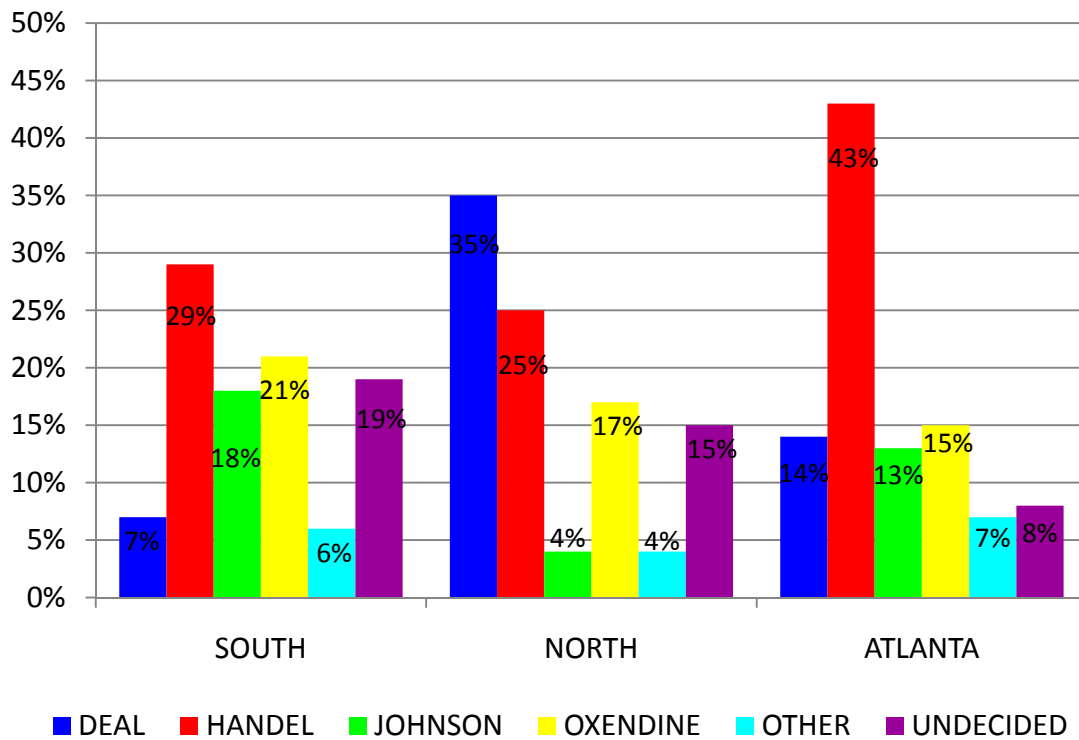
Baton Rouge, LA - Based on a Magellan Strategies survey of 1,227 likely Republican primary voters, Secretary of State Karen Handel has a 14 point lead over her nearest opponent. Handel is getting 32% of the vote, while former Congressman Nathan Deal and Commissioner of Insurance John Oxendine are statistically tied for second with 18%. Senator Eric Johnson has 12%, Jeff Chapman and Ray McBerry both garner 3%, while 14% remain undecided.

BALLOT BY REGION

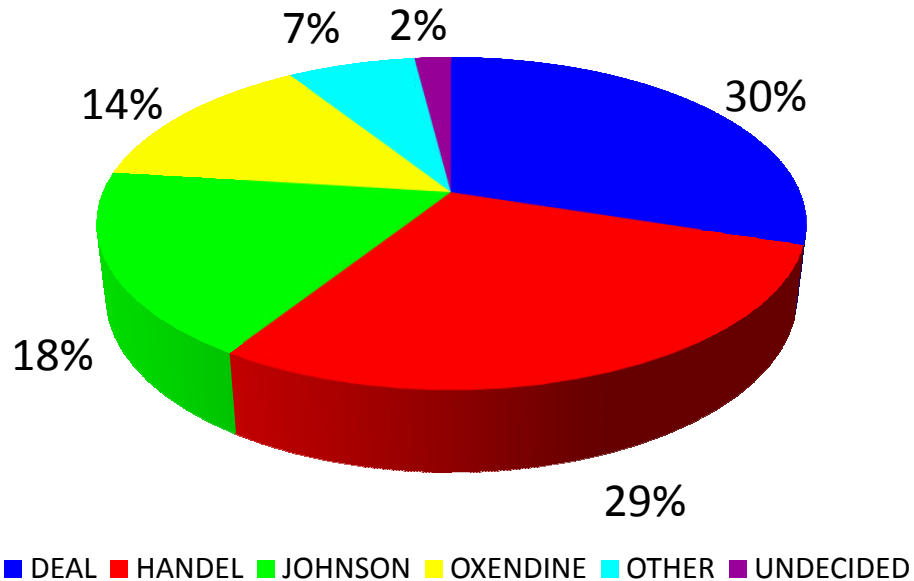
Handel's 14 point lead is buoyed by solid support in the Atlanta region and among Seniors. The Atlanta region is composed of Congressional Districts 4,5,6,7 and 13. Handel is currently polling 43% in this region and is 28 points ahead of her closest opponent. She is also the front runner in south Georgia (Congressional Districts 1, 2, 3, 8 and 12), while Deal holds his base in north Georgia (Congressional Districts 9, 10 and 11).



INFORMED VOTERS

Among voters who have heard of and know enough about each of the top 4 candidates to have an opinion, Deal leads by 1 point (Deal 30%/Handel 29%/Johnson 18% /Oxendine 14%). This would suggest that among voters paying the most attention and are most informed, the race is much tighter.

Survey Methodology

This survey was conducted using automated telephone touch tone technology. The sample for this survey was randomly drawn from a Georgia voter file. The responses were weighted to reflect the voting demographics from past Republican primary elections in the 2008, 2006, 2004 and 2002 election cycles. The 1,227 interviews were conducted Thursday night, July 8th from 6 to 8 pm. This survey has a margin of error of +/-2.8% at the 95 percent confidence interval.
